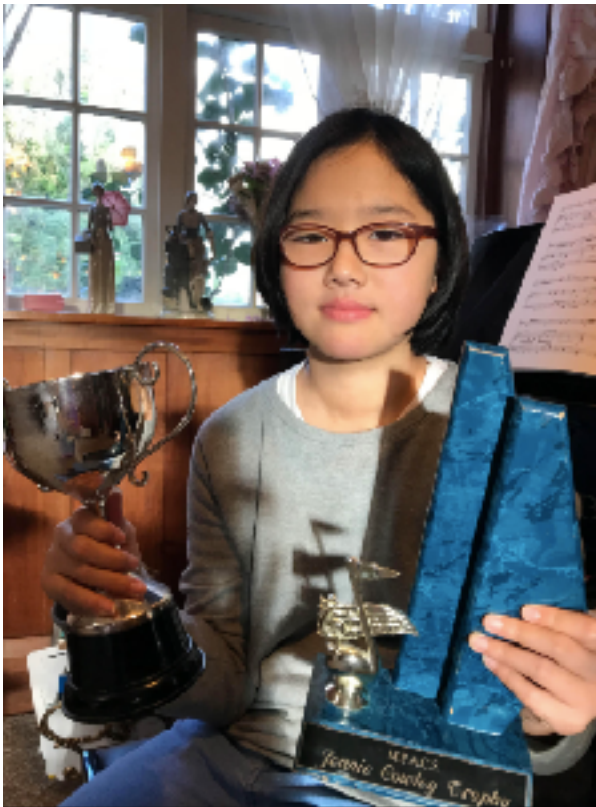
Teachers Paid Union Meeting

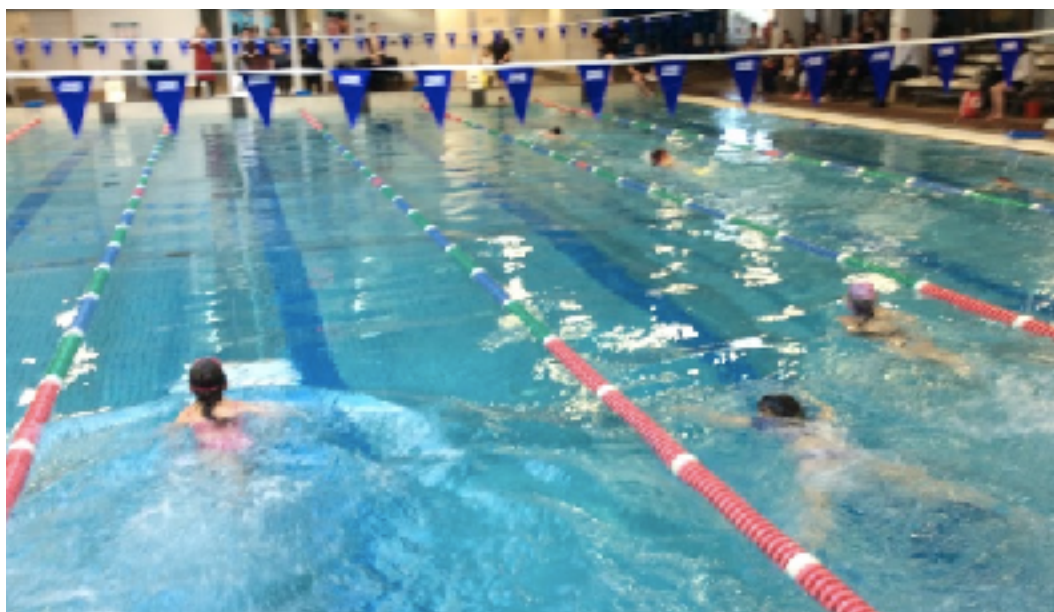
