Netball

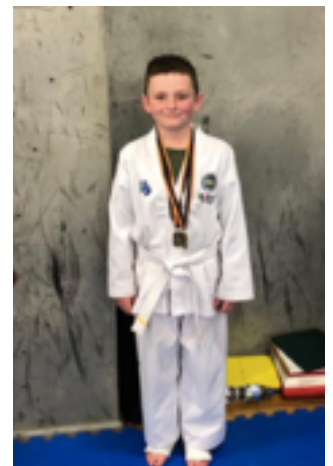
We would like to celebrate the success of the Fairfield Pukekos netball team who placed second in their netball grade. Well done on a fantastic season.
